### Fire Instructions to Volunteers

The Revels Team wishes you all to have a safe and secure Revels. Below are a few reminders to those of you volunteering to help with the Revels organisation. If you have any queries on these instructions, please call The Chief Steward / Fire Marshal on 07540 409031. Remember in the case of a fire, people will look to **you** for advice and guidance.

#### General Rule

Whenever a fire is discovered, irrespective of whether it appears extinguished the  
FIRE SERVICE MUST BE CALLED USING THE 999 SYSTEM.

Do not reply on the word of a member of the public etc. make the call yourself.

#### Give the location to the Fire Service as

The Green, Croxley Green, Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire.

#### LOCATION OF FIRE EQUIPMENT

There are 2 fire extinguishers at the entrance to Revels Control that is located behind the main Arena. Instructions on how to use them are on the side of the extinguisher but make yourself familiar with them if you have never used one before.

#### Stallholders

Keep an eye on stalls selling hot food or using generators or other electrical equipment. If you are unhappy about the use of any of this equipment or you believe the public may be at risk, please report your worries to the Chief Steward / Fire Marshall on 07540 409031.

*There is no such thing as a stupid call and your concern just may save someone's life*

#### Car Parking

Car parking Marshals should be aware that grass under parked cars can be a fire risk. At the first signs of any fire, use the fire buckets provided and call the fire service using the 999 system.

#### Evacuation Procedure

Should the Revels need to be evacuated, all personnel will be asked to evacuate the site to the SOUTH, that is across The Green towards The Triangle – Baldwins Lane – Parrots Close – Stones Orchard.

**A evacuation message will be broadcast over the Arena P.A. system and will be backed up by personnel with loudhailers making the announcement.**
